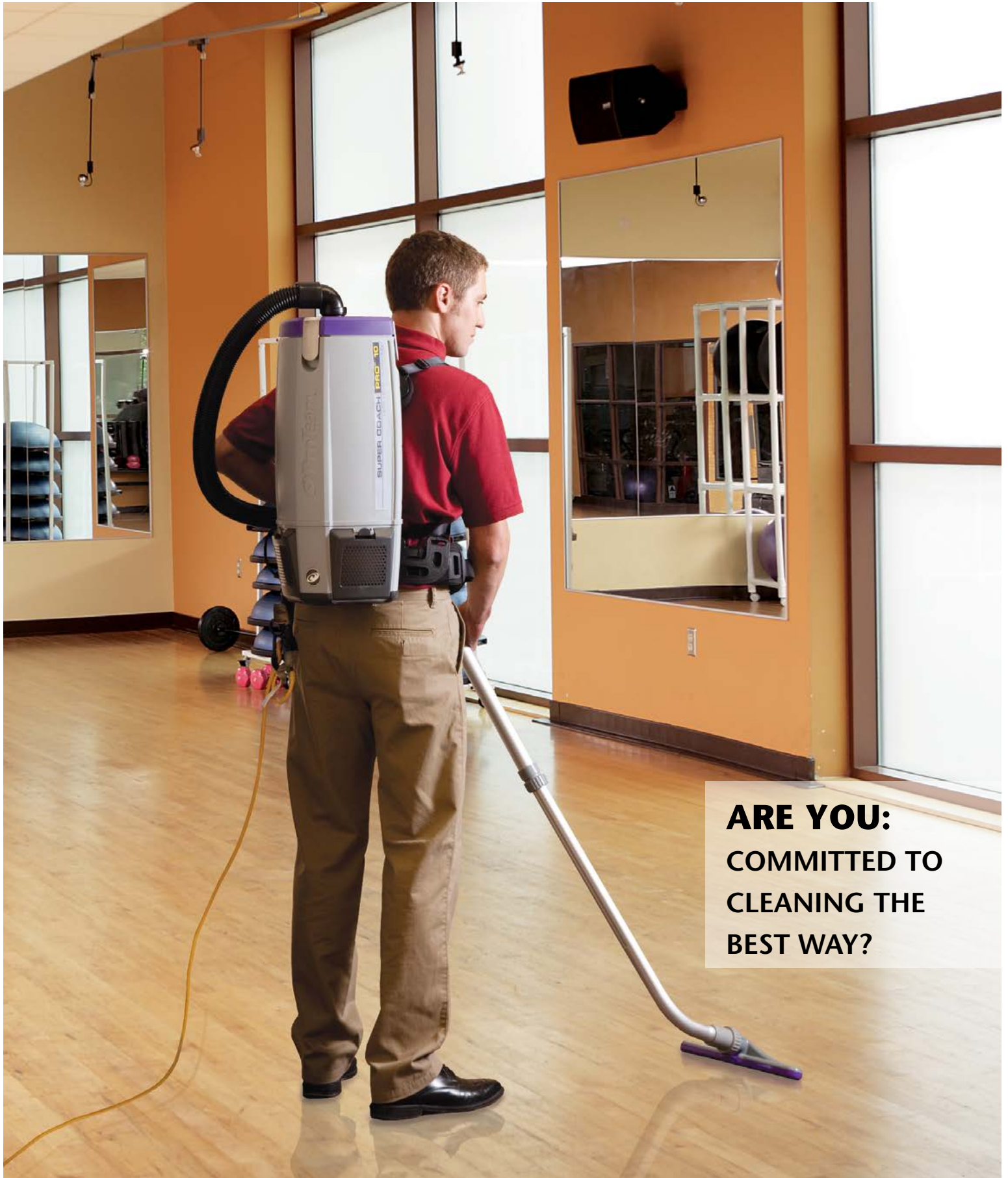

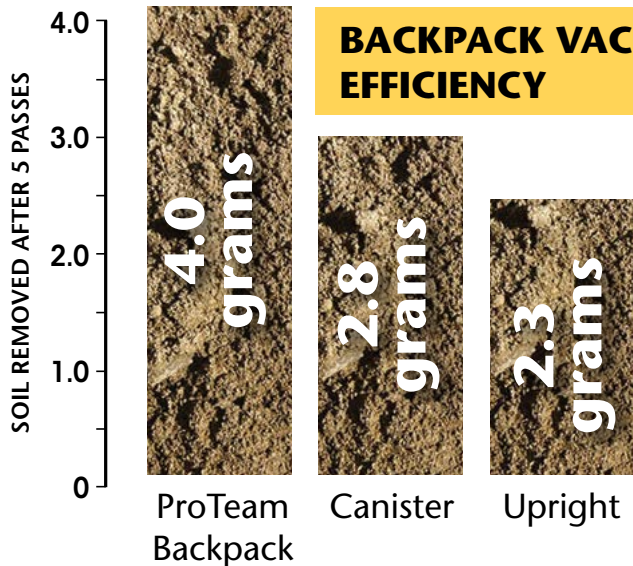
A CLOSER LOOK

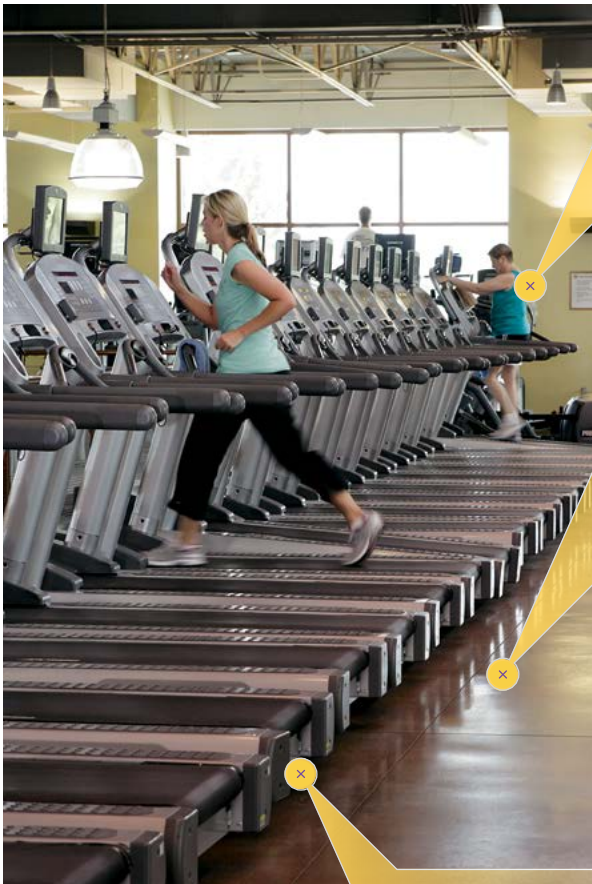

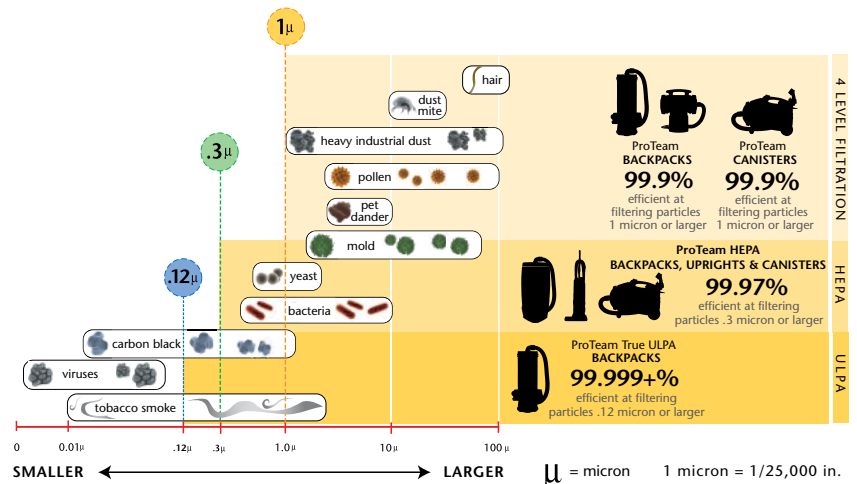
